Trade Site Application Terms and Conditions

ACCESS TO SITES - Operators may have access to set up their site from 1.00pm to 7.00pm on Friday, 23rd February preceding the Show. On Show Day, setup can be done from 7.00am to 8.30am. Sites can be dismantled ONLY after 4.00pm unless authorised by the Grounds Director and all Sites must be vacated by 5.00pm on Sunday, 26th February.

ACCOMMODATION - Camping is not permitted on the Angaston Show grounds. Accommodation can be obtained locally around the Barossa.

CAR PARKING - An allocated number of Operators are permitted to park within the Angaston Show Grounds area for the duration of the Show, in the assigned areas.

CLEAN UP - All equipment and items used and displayed in the trade site must be removed promptly after the Show.

ELECTRICAL CORDS AND APPLIANCES - All electrical cords and appliances used at Angaston Show area must carry a current, valid test tag of compliance and be set up safely. This will be checked.

FIRE SAFETY - In the event of a total fire ban, the CFS rules and regulations will be enforced.

FIRST AID - An Ambulance will attend the Angaston Show to provide emergency First Aid. There are First Aiders on the Show Committee as well. Please report to the Show Office if an incident report is required.

GATE PASSES - Each Trade Site Application includes two gate passes and one car pass valid for the day. More PASSES are available for purchase @ \$5.00 per ticket. See the Application Form for more details.

MARQUEE / ANY PEGS - **No star droppers or pegs** are to be used AT ALL. Alternate measures need to be taken to weigh your items down. Please note, all gazebos must be weighted down due to potential wind gusts and for safety reasons. Cement blocks or water drums are ideal. If you are seen damaging the grounds in any way you will be asked to leave and compensation may be sought.

INSURANCE - Liability Insurance must be valid for all Operators for the entire event including setting up and removal. A copy of the liability insurance must be submitted once your site application has been approved by the Trade Site Coordinator.

LIQUOR LICENSE - Any Operator wishing to have alcoholic beverages onsite for tasting or sale MUST receive approval from the Angaston Show Committee, and obtain a temporary license from the Liquor and Gambling Commission. A copy of the license must be supplied to the Secretary prior to the Show.

NOISE CONTROL - The Committee reserves the right to control or prohibit the operation of any machinery or equipment which causes undue noise, nuisance or inconvenience to other Operators or the Public.

PETS - Pets of Operators are permitted on the Angaston Show grounds area, but must be appropriately restrained always.

POWER - Power service is limited, please advise on the application form if you require power.

SAFETY - Operators demonstrating machinery are warned of the danger of fire and injury. Safety regulations MUST be complied with and proper guards fitted. This will be checked.

SECURITY - Security Patrols are provided during the Friday night prior to the Show and during Show Day, but the Committee will not accept any liability for any damages or loss of the Operator's equipment or Property.

SITES - All sites must be fully set up and ready to trade by 9.00am on Saturday Show day. Any Sites who arrive after 9.00am WILL NOT be permitted onto the Showgrounds.

WASTE REMOVAL - Council bins will be provided for Trade Site waste around the grounds and there is a large skip provided for larger rubbish.

1. Site applications must be received by 5pm Friday 12th January 2024.
2. No refunds will be issued if cancelled up to 1 week prior to Show date.
3. The Trade site coordinator reserves the right to place trade site holders where deemed appropriate. Where possible they will accommodate special requests but are under no obligation to do so.
4. Any member of the committee shall have the power to remove any articles, signs, pictures, or printed matter which in their opinion may be a cause of offence to the public or the officials of the committee or which the committee deems inappropriate.
5. In the event that it should be found necessary or expedient to cancel or postpone the said Show, a notice of such cancellation or postponement will be published at the earliest practicable time. Upon such a cancellation or postponement, the Society shall not be liable to any exhibitor for any compensation, whether on the grounds of loss of profits or otherwise in respect of such cancellation or postponement.
6. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry of any exhibitor or refuse to allot space to any exhibitor if in the opinion of the committee, there is any infringement on any of the foregoing conditions and/or if the exhibitor does not occupy the space at the commencement of and during the full period of the said Show.
7. A speed limit of 5 kilometres per hour shall apply at all times within the confines of the show grounds.
8. Food/Drink Sites: Once Applications have been approved a Food Business Number must be sent through to the committee.
9. The Operator always shall exercise all necessary precautions for the safety of the public, employees and others appropriate to the nature of the site/demonstration and the conditions under which the event is conducted. Notwithstanding any directions or approvals given by the Grounds Director, the Operator shall always be held responsible for the safety of all persons engaged in the operation of the site/demonstration.
10. The Operator accepts all responsibility for and shall hold the Committee indemnified against any death, personal injury, damage or loss to any person, persons or property howsoever arising and whether at, or in consequence of the Show by reason of any act, omission or neglect of the Operator, or arising out of the transport, installation, use or demonstration of any machinery, implement, apparatus, static display or stand, and the Operator hereby undertakes to faithfully conform with any regulations, by laws or ordinances made under such Acts of Parliament or by any Government, Semi Government or Local Government Authority duly authorised to make regulations, by laws, or ordinances in connection herewith, and with any such directions as the Grounds Director may give.
11. The Operator shall promptly report to the Grounds Director all accidents involving death, personal injury, damage or loss to any person, persons or property and all incidents with accident potential such as equipment, structure or infrastructure failure and the like. If required, the Grounds Director shall ask for an incident/accident report which must be provided to the Grounds Director or the Secretary within 48 hours of the incident/accident.

13. Any private pets brought into the said area by the Operator shall be appropriately restrained always for the duration of the Show, to the satisfaction of the Grounds Director and all animal waste is to be removed at the conclusion of the Show.
